President: Bob Smith called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM, welcoming members and reminding them that they may speak on any subject brought before the Board. Member Jack Johnson has made a \$40.00 donation to WAPA. Alan Patton donated a 1926 Hercules engine to the Club, and President Smith asked whether anyone might have a Wico EK mag that they would be willing to donate for this engine. As this is the annual meeting for nominations to the Board for 2023, President Smith asked Secretary Stockton if we had a quorum (148 members) present, with Secretary affirming. Nominations were opened as follows: Editors: Carol Haskell & Ellen Morse; Purchasing: Paul Montgomery; Safety: Tim Neely; Museum: Ron Haskell; Membership: Brian Stoops; Show Director: Mitchell Reichwein; Treasurer: Kelley Garcia; Secretary: Lance Wilson; Vice President: Jim Treadwell; President: needs to have a nomination from floor, no nomination, so Bob Smith has been drafted as President. Nominations closed. Officers confirmed.

Vice President: office left open in memory of Carey Stockton.

Secretary: Dave Stockton made a motion to approve the minutes of the Board of Directors meeting held on August 6, 2022, second by Mitchell Reichwein with all in favor and entered into record without correction.

Treasurer: Kelley Garcia presented the banking report; checking acct. balance at \$4,983.20, savings acct. at \$37,646.07, total investments at \$174,407.11. Kelley reported that 2021 tax returns have been filed.

Membership: Jim Treadwell furnished report as follows: total membership is 161 with 100 having dues paid to date. Motion by Jim to approve for membership Joseph Mayo, second by Dave Stockton with all in favor.

Purchasing: Lance Wilson has WAPA shirts and hats for sale. Lance had a visit with Phil Sigmon recently and encourages all to go see him if you can.

Show Director: Mitchell Reichwein gave report as follows; The Fort MacArthur show had ten members displaying. The Rubel Castle tour is set for Saturday September 10. The Glendora Pumpkin Festival is on Saturday Oct. 15, with a motion to sanction, second by Ron Haskell with all in favor.

Safety: Director Tim Neely had no report.

Museum: Director Ron Haskell gave an update on the ongoing work to the building and is getting estimates on having the roof of the building insulated with a spray-on type of material. Repair and maintenance work is ongoing to the tractors for October's Cal Poly events.

Editors: Carol Haskell and Ellen Morse would like to have all articles, stories, ads, etc. to them by the 20th of each month for inclusion in the newsletter. They ask that any articles, pictures, etc. be sent as an attachment to the e-mail.

Cal Poly: Bob Smith announced that the Cal Poly Pumpkin Festival will be each Friday, Saturday and Sunday in October and needs tractor drivers for each day. Additionally, there will be an engine display every Saturday and Sunday in October. Sign-up sheets are available and President Smith says he expects 100% participation.

Riverside Citrus Grove Project: President Smith announced that he will be dropping this topic from the agenda, and that Museum Director Ron Haskell can report on any future work at the site under the heading "New Business"; the same applies with the Rubel Castle's Western engine start-up.

Committee Report: Ron Haskell says that the 5-Year Plan has been greatly scaled back.


