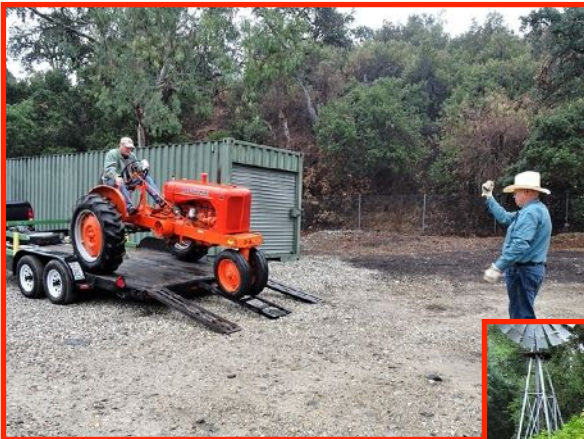

Membership: Jim Treadwell, absent, furnished report as follows: total membership is 152 with 109 having dues paid to date. Motion by Kelley Garcia to drop from membership Steve Lester, second by Mitchell Reichwein with all in favor. Motion by Dave Stockton to accept for membership Charles Nance, second by Ron Haskell with all in favor. The following members will be moved to life membership: Terry Klenske, Tom Reifer and Larry Madole. Dave Ruhland earns a recruiter pin. New Membership Director Brian Stoops reminds everyone to pay their 2023 dues by January 1.

Purchasing: Lance Wilson has WAPA shirts and hats for sale.

Show Director: Mitchell Reichwein gave report as follows; Flabob Airport Show is on Saturday November 12 with a motion to sanction, second by Ron Haskell with all in favor.

Safety: Director Tim Neely reminded members to have currently certified fire extinguishers on hand and in place at all shows.

Museum: Director Ron Haskell announced that the WAPA Fun Day will be Saturday January 14, 2023 at our new building. Work on the building is on-going. Ron & Bob need volunteers, so contact them if you can help out.
