



Treasurer: Kelley Garcia presented financial report. Anonymous donor gave \$80. Savings \$36,419.15; WAPA Museum \$172,906.01; Checking \$10,848.72.

Membership: Brian Stoops, absent. Total membership is 144. Active dues paying members are 105. Lifetime members: 34; Honorary members: 4; Complimentary members: 1. Fifty four members have paid dues so far. Lance Bryant was dropped from membership at his request. Life member Barbara Moody passed away 3 years ago. Lifetime members Steve Lester and Giles Rowlands passed away. Lifetime member Mike Andrews letter was returned.

Purchasing: Paul Montgomery — WAPA has apparel for sale. Paul asked the members if anyone had a cabinet to donate for storing WAPA apparel.

Safety: Tim Neely: Safety issues.

Shows: Mitchell Reichwein made a motion to sanction Calico California Days on February 18–19. Second by Dave Foley. All in favor. Discussion on Chino Days on March 18–19. Chino cannot pay WAPA so the show will not be sanctioned. Members may attend on their own. Highland Citrus Festival is schedule for March 25. Cal Poly Easter Egg Hunt will be on April 1–2.
